

### July 2011 to June 2012

This report summarises recorded injury attendances to Fairfield General Emergency Department (ED) between July 2011 and June 2012.




### Figure 1: Fairfield General Hospital ED: Total injury attendances by gender and month, July 2011 to June 2012

Between July 2011 and June 2012 there were 24,603 injury attendances to Fairfield General Hospital ED. Males accounted for just over half (53%) of all attendances. The month with the highest injury attendances was July (n=2,393) with December (n=1,840) having the lowest (Figure 1). Almost seven in ten (69%) of injury attendances were recorded as other injury. Of the specified injury groups, falls (16%) accounted for the highest proportion followed by road traffic collisions (RTCs) (5%) and assault (5%) (Table 1).

For all injury attendances, the highest proportions were for persons aged 5 to 19 (24%) and 20 to 34 years (23%) (Figure 2). Almost six in ten (55%) of fall attendees were aged 65 or over. Over half (51%) of assault attendees were aged 20 to 34 years. Two-fifths (40%) of RTC attendees and over a third (36%) of deliberate self-harm (DSH) attendees were aged 20 to 34 years (Figure 3).

**Table 2** shows the location of the incident of injury attendances. Over two-fifths (42%) of injuries occurred in the home. Almost one in six (16%) of injuries occurred in a public place with smaller proportions occurring at work (6%) or at an educational establishment (5%). Half (50%) of

assaults occurred in a public place. Over seven in ten (73%) of DSH injuries occurred at home. Almost six in ten (57%) falls occurred in the home.


Table 3 shows the ethnicity of attendees to FairfieldGeneral Hospital ED. Almost nine in ten (86%) werewhite and 6% were Pakistani.

The disposal of a patient can give an indication of the severity of the injuries sustained. Most (63%) attendees were discharged, over a quarter (27%) had a referral/follow-up and 8% were admitted (Table 4). Over three-quarters (76%) of RTC attendees were discharged. Almost a quarter (24%) of fall attendees were admitted and over two-fifths (45%) of burns and scalds attendees had a referral/follow-up (Table 5).

**Table 6** shows the arrival methods of injury attendances at Fairfield General Hospital ED. Over two-thirds (67%) arrived by private transport while a fifth (20%) arrived by ambulance.

**Table 7** shows assault attendances to Fairfield General ED. Over seven in ten (71%) assault attendees were male and over half (51%) were aged 20 to 34 years. Over two-fifths (43%) of assault attendances arrived at the ED by ambulance.


