

Injury attendances to Royal Albert Edward Infirmary Emergency Department

## July 2010 to June 2011

This report summarises recorded injury attendances to Royal Albert Edward Infirmary Emergency Department (ED) between July 2010 and June 2011.

From July 2010 to June 2011 there were 35,345 injury attendances to Royal Albert Edward Infirmary ED. Males accounted for over half (56%) of all attendances. The month with the highest attendances for injury was May (n=3,265) with January (n=2,526) having the lowest attendances (Figure 1). The majority (92%) of attendances were recorded as other accident. Assaults accounted for 4% of all injury attendances, road traffic collisions (RTC) 3% and deliberate self-harm (DSH) 2% (Table 1).




Figure 3: Royal Albert Edward Infirmary ED: Total injury attendances by age group and injury group, July 2010 to June 2011

For all injuries, the highest proportions of attendances were for persons aged 5 to 19 (27%) and 20 to 34 (23%) (Figure 2). Almost four in ten (39%) deliberate self harm (DSH) attendees were aged 20 to 34 (Figure 3).

**Table 2** shows the location of the incident of injury attendances. Half (50%) of injuries occurred in the home; 7% occurred in a public place or at work whilst 5% occurred at an educational establishment.

**Table 3** shows the ethnicity of injury attendees to Royal Albert Edward Infirmary ED. Over nine in ten (96%) were recorded as white, 3% were recorded as not known.

The disposal of a patient can give an indication of the severity of the injuries sustained. Over a half (55%) were discharged, nearly four in ten (39%) were referred and 4% were admitted (Table 4). Over four in five (84%) of RTC attendees were discharged. Nearly four in five (38%) assault attendees and nearly a third (32%) of DSH attendees had a referral/follow-up (Table 5).

**Table 6** shows the arrival methods of injury attendances at Royal Albert Edward Infirmary ED. Around one in seven (14%) arrived by ambulance.

Table 7 shows assault attendances to Royal Albert Edward Infirmary ED. Over seven in ten (72%) of assault attendees were male, and over a quarter (28%) occurred in a public place (Figure 3). Over a third (34%) of assault attendees arrived at the ED by ambulance, and over a quarter (27%) of assault attendances occurred at weekend nights.

Figure 1: Royal Albert Edward Infirmary ED: Total injury attendances by gender and month, July 2010 to June 2011



Figure 2: Royal Albert Edward Infirmary ED: Total injury attendances by age group and month, July 2010 to June 2011


